



August 7 2020 COVID-19 Update

We continue to be impacted by the Novel Coronavirus (which causes COVID-19). Statewide the percent of positive tests has been generally increasing, and nationally there have been significant increases in the percent of tests that return positive.

Consequently, we are continuing to require masks for all staff while on duty anywhere except in the staff member's private office, and temperature checks as all staff in all locations report to work. Additional protective measures are added as needed to address specific situations involving staff and/or clients.

The results of these practices have been clear – there has only been one reported positive case for COVID-19.

This is a direct result of everyone practicing good personal protection and hand-washing both on and off duty, and contacting Renee Clevenger, Director of Nursing, at the first sign of any symptoms that might suggest COVID-19.
